#### Building an RRI-SSH Ecosystem

During the first 6 months of the project, HubIT conducted an “ecosystem mapping” exercise. The objective was to collate, clarify, curate and publish information about responsible ICT research and innovation projects, actors, activities and initiatives.

The resulting databases of projects and actors contain 120 projects from 20 countries and 552 actors from 486 organisations and 37 countries.
