About Project

The international project Eurograduate focuses on monitoring the transition of university graduates from school to the labour market. It follows on from the first round of pilot survey, which was carried out in 2018 and involved 8 countries. 17 countries will participate in the second round of pilot survey, which will be carried out between 2022 and 2024. In the conditions of the Slovak Republic, this survey will replace the national survey that was carried out in the past by the Slovak Centre of Scientific and Technical Information (in 2008, 2013 and 2019) for the Ministry of Education, Science, research and sport of the Slovak Republic. The objectives of the project will be ensured through an online questionnaire survey, and its output will be national reports and comparative analysis for all participating countries.

Target Group

The target group of the survey is graduates of the first, second and combined first and second degree of university studies in full-time or part-time form, who successfully completed their studies at the given degree in the academic years 2016/2017 or 2020/2021, that is, they are five years after completing university studies. As part of the survey, only the graduates selected for the sample, which will be created through a random stratified selection, will be contacted.

Form of contact

Respondents will be contacted by e-mail. In cases where it is not possible to ensure email contacts with graduates in any way, classic mail will be used.
